Born June 14, 1944 in Tiffin, OH, he is survived by his wife of 17 years, Nancy L. Yost. Preceded in death by his parents, Eugene X. Yost and Geneva (Reinhart) Yost, and a brother Anthony Yost. Survivors include his brother Frank (spouse Lynn) Yost of Huston, DE, and brother Michael (spouse Kathleen) Yost of Tiffin, OH.
