BRANDT, Marilyn Nye, age 87, of Palm Harbor, died Friday, December 14, 2012 at Brookside Hospice in Palm Harbor. She was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, the oldest child of Mr. & Mrs. Milo A. Nye of Albion, Indiana. Marilyn was graduated from Albion High School, now Central Noble High School, class of 1943. She attended Purdue University and was graduated in 1947 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Nutritional Science. She was a member of the Alpha Delta Pi sorority.
