ROBERT J. CABRAL, formerly of Cambridge and Arlington, MA, died at home in Odessa, Florida on Saturday, April 16, 2011. Bob is survived by his beloved wife Kathryn M.; his sons David W. of Holland, MA, and Robert L. and his wife Kristine of Brandon, Florida; his daughters Kathryn A. of Florida, and Debra M. Cabral and her husband John Oppedisano of Alexandria, Virginia; his brother William Cabral and his wife Betty of Highland Beach, Florida; and his cherished grandchildren: Marta, David, Sean, Kevin, Katrina, and William. Bob was born January 21, 1931 in Cambridge, MA, to William and Martha Cabral. He was a 1948 graduate of Cambridge High and Latin School and a Veteran of the United States Air Force.
