**C**AREY, Clark W. was born on August 26, 1941 in the town of Perth Amboy, New Jersey. Clark attended college at Rutgers University and was in the military reserves. He worked for Timex Corporation for 33 years. While at Timex he held many positions in sales and marketing and prior to retirement he was President of Acqua Time Corporation, a subsidiary of Timex. Clark moved to Dunedin in 1997 from Connecticut. While in Dunedin, he made many friends and joined many groups. He was a proud member of the Dunedin Historical Society, the Dunedin Boat Club, and the North Pinellas Republican Club. He was the President of the Monroe Park Homeowners' Association and volunteered for the city of Dunedin serving over 5 years on the public relations board. Clark is preceded in death by his mother and father, Doris and Clark Sr. He is survived by his loving partner in life, Andrea Dixon and his sister Denise Carey-Gallagher (Daniel).
