Judith Elaine Wolf, nee Steih passed away August 13th, 2015 quietly at home surrounded by her family, she was 76 years old.

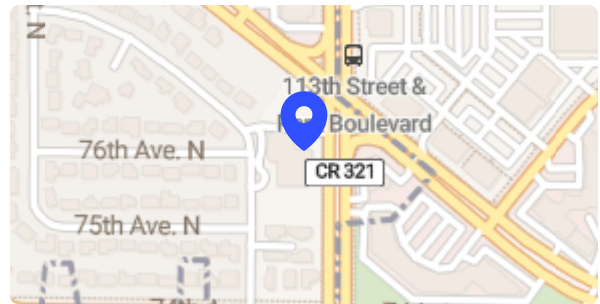
