They moved to Lima, a small town in upstate New York where they raised their children, and she worked with her husband in his chiropractic office for many years. Lois was a member of the Order of Eastern Star in Lima. She was also a member of the DAR (Daughters of American Revolution). Lois and Bill retired to Dunedin, Florida and enjoyed many years together pitching horseshoes as members of the Clearwater Horseshoe Club. 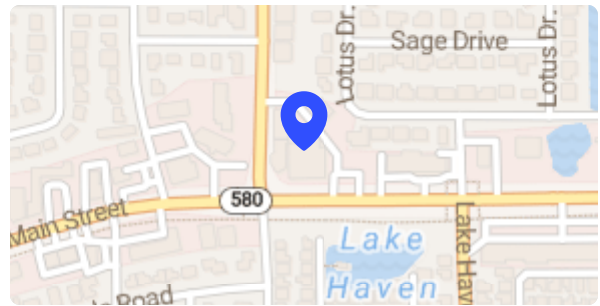

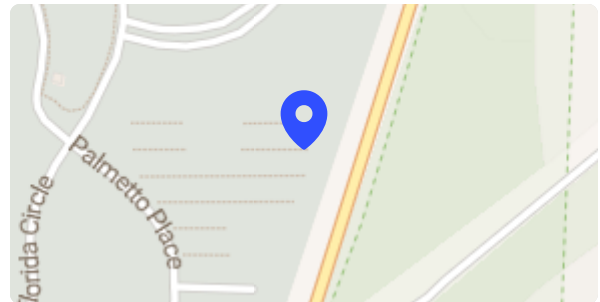
