Jean Helen Perriman was born in Evanston, Illinois on September 9, 1931, the only beloved child born to Edmond and Helen Hebel. She graduated from Broad Ripple High School in Indianapolis, Indiana in 1949 and Dennison College in 1953. She is also a graduate from Katherine Gibbs Secretarial School in Boston, Mass. Following her education she married her first husband, Dr. Richard Chamberlin. She devoted the next several years to starting her family and raising her four children first in Waterville, Maine and then Clearwater, Florida. As a single mother with four children she moved to Clearwater to be close to her parents. Jean quickly became engaged in the community through variety service organizations including Skycrest United Methodists Church, Scouting, PTA, and P.E.O. Often taking on leadership roles with local and state chapters. In 1972 Jean married William "Bill" D. Perriman. They enjoyed a wonderful life together, blending two families.
