Edwin "Ed" Lee Chasteen, 74, of Dunedin, Florida, passed peacefully Thursday, June 16, 2016 at Suncoast Hospice in Palm Harbor, Florida.

Eldest son of Marion and Irene (Chaney), he was born in Hamilton, Ohio on September 13, 1941. He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers, Ronald and Gerald Chasteen. An avid sportsman, Ed played baseball and basketball from his youth until graduation from Fairfield High School in 1959. He went on to play seven years in the minor leagues, but injuries kept him from getting to the majors.

Ed was the owner of Shoreline Delivery Services until his retirement in 2011.

He is survived by his loving wife of 50 years, Charlotte (McKinney); two sons, Todd and wife Sondra of Atlanta, Georgia, Scott and wife Amanda of Land O'Lakes, Florida; three grandchildren, Todd Jr, Sean and Eric. Ed was a member of Harbor Life Church of God in Safety Harbor, Florida.
