Loretta Ballow Staar was born in The Bronx on March 11, 1930 to Minnie (Hannemann) and Otto Stackler. She graduated from Walton High School in 1948, and married George Ballow in October of 1950. After he served in The Marines during the Korean Conflict, and living in Californian for a few years they moved back to New York. After George died tragically in 1970, Loretta married Louis Staar in February of 1974, and they moved to Clearwater, Florida. 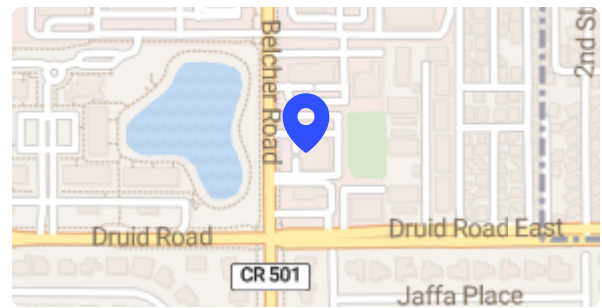

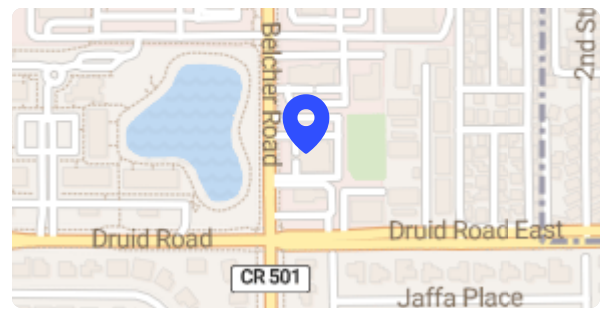
