**B**etty D. Hendricks, age 93 of Clearwater, passed away peacefully on February 18, 2017 at home with her family at her bedside. Born August 29, 1923 in Bedford, IN to parents Joseph Roscoe Hitchcock and Mabel E. Sargent, she was the younger sister of Herman, Mary and Helen and older sister to her beloved brother James (all deceased). She is preceded in death by her husband of 62 years, James E. Hendricks.

Betty worked as a secretary at Crane Naval Depot (Indiana) and General Motors while James attended Indiana University School of Dentistry. 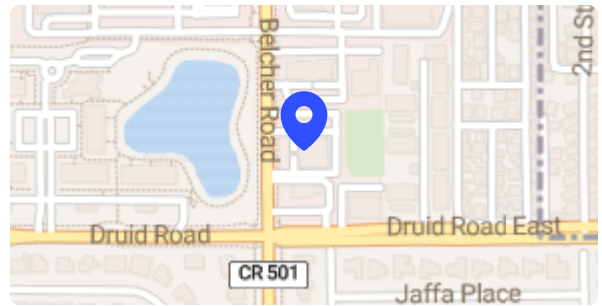

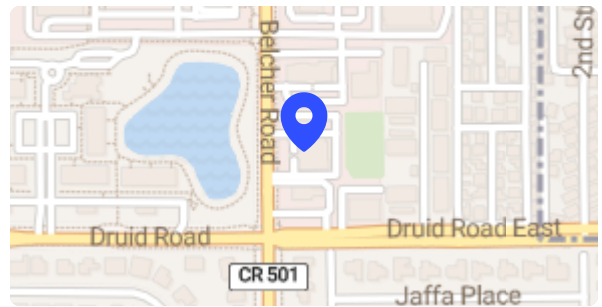
