A Memorial Mass will be held on Wednesday, August 16, 2017 at St. Michael the Archangel Catholic Church in Clearwater, Florida.

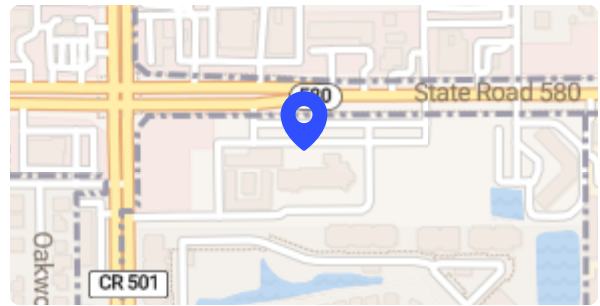
