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Kendra Brown, 38, of Palm Harbor passed away on January 19th, 2018 surrounded by her family. She is survived by her husband, Wayne, her children Jordon and Gary, her parents Karen and Malcolm Deane, her brother Justin Deane, her two nephews Jaden and Gianni, and many Aunts, Uncles, Cousins and friends. A memorial service will be held at Northwood Presbyterian Church in Clearwater on Saturday, February 24th at 11am.

Kendra was born in Manchester, New Hampshire, but moved with her family to Florida in 1988. She attended Largo High School. After High School she pursued a career in the legal field, and was a Paralegal with McManus and McManus in Largo. In 2004 Kendra married her husband, Wayne Brown and in 2005 helped Wayne adopt her son, Jordon. In 2014 They adopted their son Gary. Kendra retired early due to illness. 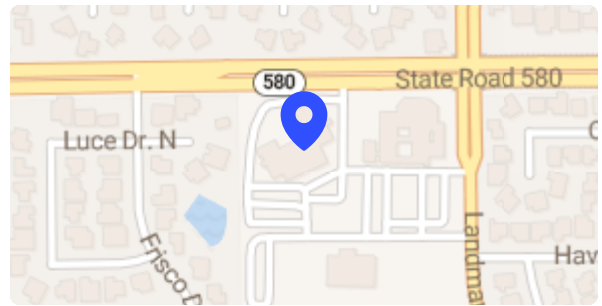
