Brendan Richard Saunders, age 49, passed away from natural causes at his home in Largo, Florida on Wednesday, March 28, 2018. A beloved husband, father, sibling, and son, he will be remembered for his love of family, music, cars, and electronics. After graduating from Clearwater Central Catholic High School, he earned his Doctorate in Pharmacy from Nova Southeastern University. He worked as a pharmacist in Pinellas County, Jacksonville, and Kissimmee before health issues forced him to leave the field.
