David Wilmer Ko, 97, passed away peacefully in Dunedin, Florida, on Saturday, October 20, 2018. Born in Philadelphia to parents Henry Tung Sing Ko and Florence Lee Jow Ko, Dave spent most of his life in the Philadelphia area. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II, serving in Europe. He and his brother Wesley were business owners, running a printing business together for 40 years in Philadelphia and later in upstate New York. He eventually retired to Hampstead, North Carolina.
