**G**eorge Gordon Moore Rees, 50 passed away peacefully on October 24, 2018 at home in Belleair, Florida. Gordon was born on October the 21st, 1968 in Columbus, Georgia and adored by his two loving parents, Steven and Mamie Rees. 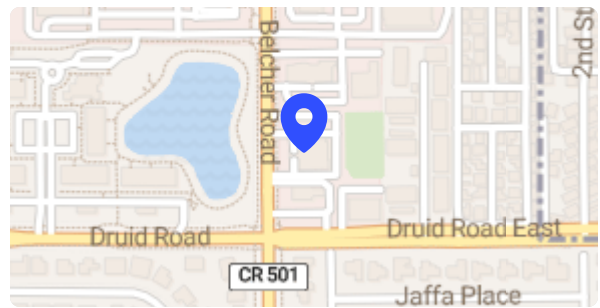

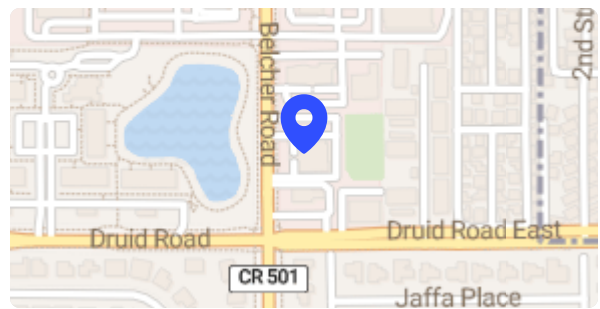

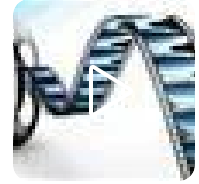
