## **Dr. Stephen R. Wood**

**S**tephen R. Wood D.O., 67, died at 2:04pm, Friday, February 21st 2020, from complications related to esophageal cancer, at Largo Medical center, in Largo, Florida, hand in hand with his family.

Stephen was born October 15, 1952, in Redfield, South Dakota. He was a resident of Doland, South Dakota, Creve Coeur, St. Louis, MO, and currently Seminole, Fl. He worked as an Orthopedic Surgeon with Suncoast Orthopedics, in Seminole, Florida. He specialized in sports medicine since 1985. His fellowship was in the College of Surgeons in 1995. He was a graduate of Kirksville College and a fellow of the American Osteopathic Society. He was an excellent trumpet player, avid walker, book enthusiast, and enjoyed dancing to jazz music.

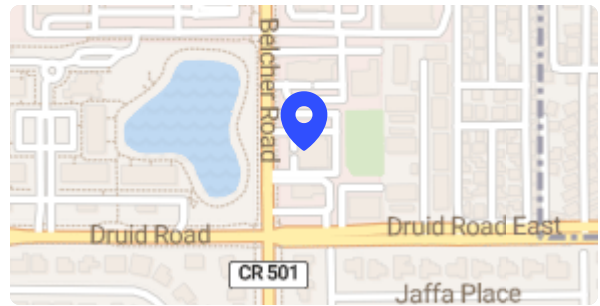

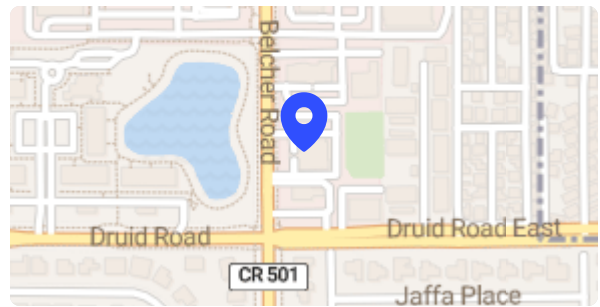
