## **Gordon M. Methvin**

**G**ordon M. Methvin, 89, of Clearwater, Florida passed away Monday, April 6, 2020 at Palm Garden of Largo, where he was loved and well cared for. Gordon was born May 24, 1930 in Anniston, Alabama to DeArman and Berta (Johnson) Methvin. He moved to this area in 1968 from Anniston having served his country as a corpsman in the US Navy during the Korean conflict. Gordon was a faithful member and a beloved church elder at Central Church of Christ in Clearwater for many years. He also served on the Board of Directors of the Florida School of Preaching in Lakeland, Florida. Besides his parents, Gordon is preceded in death by a brother, Col. Joseph Methvin, ret. US Army. Gordon is survived by his wife of (almost) 64 years, Eva Jane; a son, Doug; daughter, Debbie, sisters-in-law, Alice Methvin, Louise Clark and 9 nieces and nephews. Due to current health conditions the service is private.
