Theresa Marie Holloran, 55, of Largo, Florida passed Wednesday October 14, 2020 at Mease Countryside Hospital.

Theresa Marie Holloran was born April 29, 1965, to Edward L Holloran, Jr. and Mildred Jane Holloran in Indianapolis, Indiana. She attended Holy Trinity, All Saints, and Cardinal Ritter High School before attending Indiana University in Bloomington. She was a proud IU graduate majoring in elementary education with a minor in special education. She was passionate about teaching young children and loved living in Oregon for about a decade. She was married to Brian Francis Zustovich for seventeen years and they remained lifelong friends. In 2008, Theresa began work for TD Bank as a Training specialist and loved teaching thousands of new hires the "WOW" factor of customer service demanded of TD Bank personnel. She was very passionate about teaching adults and thrived in the enthusiastic, [OBJ] inclusive culture of TD Bank.

Theresa was a member of Saint Catherine of Siena Catholic Church in Largo, Florida, where she would often wear her Indianapolis Colts' attire to Sunday morning mass during the fall. 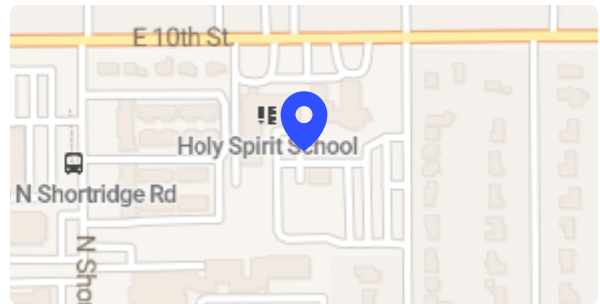

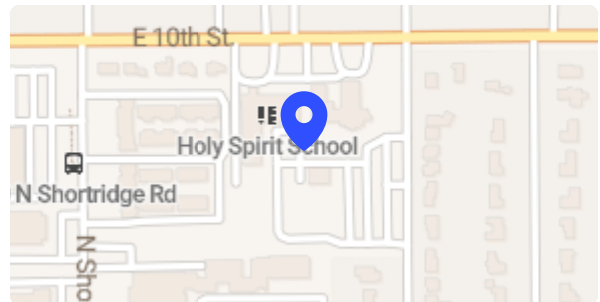
