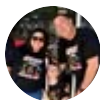

Always liked taking to her about her orchids, she would tell me about the ones at her house and I would tell her the ones I have never lasted and she would laugh.

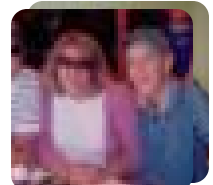

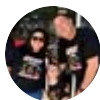
