He attended/ graduated Admiral Farragut Academy, St. Petersburg, from 1955-1957. He was a veteran of both the U.S. Army and Air Force. His service included tours in Germany, Viet Nam, Hawaii, Turkey, Iceland, and Japan. He was part of the force sent to Southern FL during the Cuban Missile Crisis. He retired from the Air Force in 1979 after 20 years and became a resident of Largo. He had a love for genealogy, photography, and history. He was a member of Largo-Seminole Community Chorus.
