Mary C. McMahon, 95, of Clearwater, FL passed away Saturday, April 16, 2022 at home. Mary was born and raised in New Rochelle, New York, the daughter of John and Hazel Connolly. She had two sisters and a brother, Joan her older sister, passed away at age 14 months, Jack, and Evelyn. She graduated from Marymount College in Tarrytown, New York with a bachelors degree in economics. She was an officer for Union Dime Savings Bank in New York until she met her soul mate, Jack, in 1954. Mary 'knew' upon meeting Jack, that her deceased grandfather had 'found her Irishman' for her! Mary & Jack were married in 1956.

They lived for three years in Norwalk, Connecticut and proudly welcomed their son Jack, in 1957. 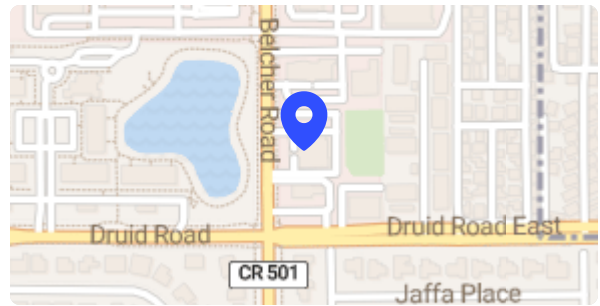

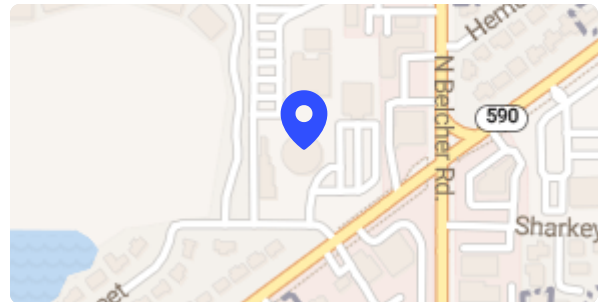

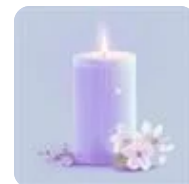
