Peter was a longtime Floridian resident who grew up and spent his life in Clearwater. Peter attended Clearwater High School where he played football for the Tornados during their big undefeated season. He graduated from High School in 1950 where he then enlisted in the U.S. Navy, serving during the Korean War on the U.S.S. Rainier. 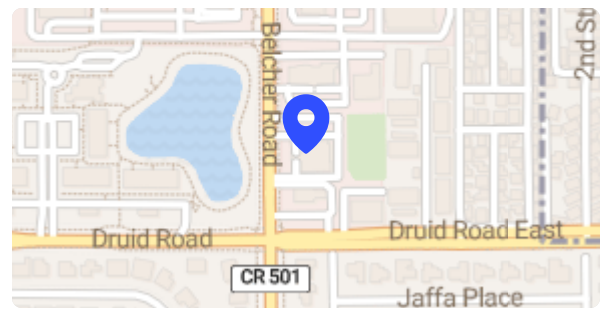

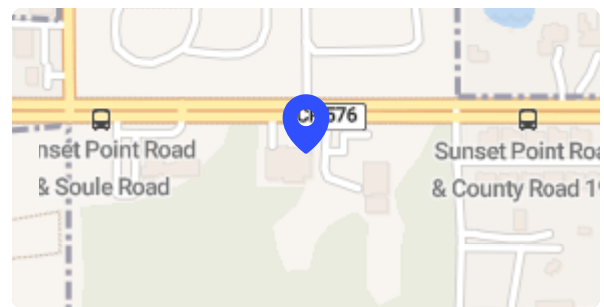
