Priscilla M. Kelley, 90, of Clearwater, Florida crossed through life's boundaries on Mother's Day, May 8th, 2022. Her strongest passions were the social interactions with her many friends and family, and more recently her caregivers at Regency Oaks. She loved to travel, to read, to entertain, to eat & drink, and to serve others. While she lived most of her life in Massachusetts and Florida, Priscilla also lived in distant places including Korea (50's) and Saudi Arabia (80's). She worked in the health care field for decades, and most recently as a clerk for Mease Hospital in Dunedin for 20+ years in medical records.

Priscilla was preceded in death by her loving, devoted husband of 33 years, Robert Kelley, and her brother John Zona who passed prematurely following cancer diagnoses. She is survived by her son Sean, his wife Jan, and daughter Tanya of Tampa; son Kevin and his wife Janice and children Matthew (and his wife Mary and son Patrick) & Christine (and husband Chris) of MA; and his son Greg, his wife Susan and children Brian and Kaitlyn of Pennsylvania.

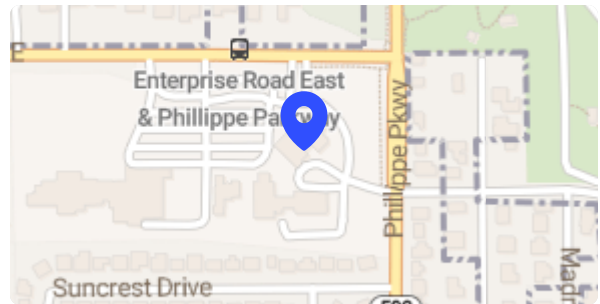

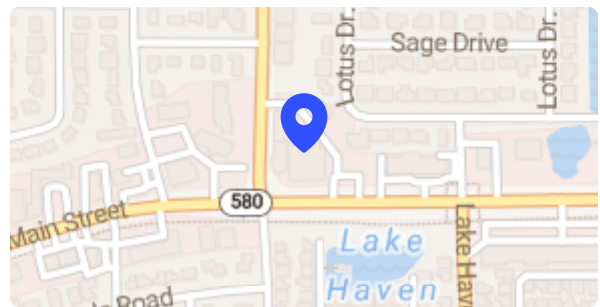

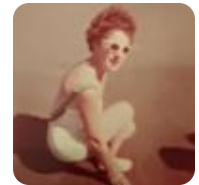
Pat Schauer posted:

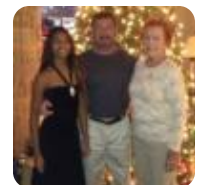

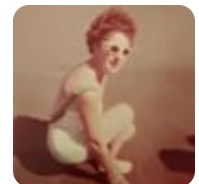
