Vincent J. Bubolo, 69, passed away April 1st, 2023.

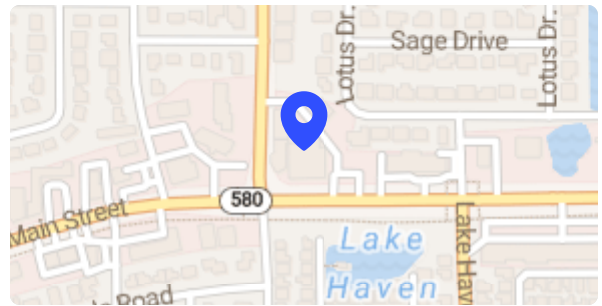

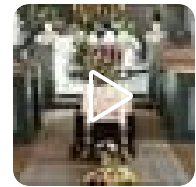
