Stacey Howard Graff, 80, of Clearwater, passed away on October 9, 2023, at the Mease Countryside Hospital in Safety Harbor, Florida. Stacey is survived by his wife of 55 years, Linda Graff (Kwasney), son David Graff (Tina Crawford), daughters Kristine (Gabe Slater) and Jennifer (Chuck Dyer), and his four grandchildren, Clayton, Emily, Kelli, and Molly (Slater).

The only child of the late Howard Graff and Beverly Clayton Graff Chapman, Stacey was born on September 9, 1943, in Salt Lake City, Utah. His move to Glendale, California led to his earning a bachelor's degree in Mathematics from UCLA. and a professional career that began with Autonetics (now a part of Boeing). He moved to Honeywell International in Florida where he spent 35 years as an engineer and operations manager in both radiation effects and avionics.
