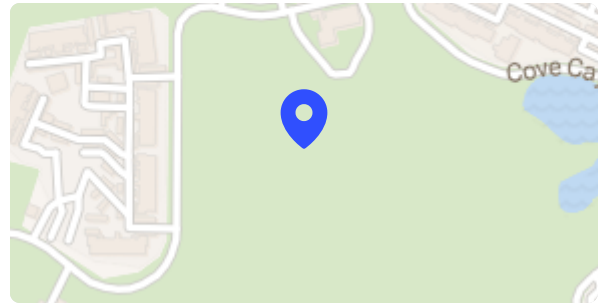

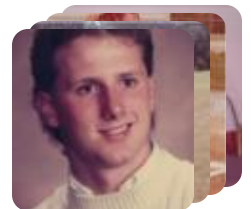
Dennis Smith posted:

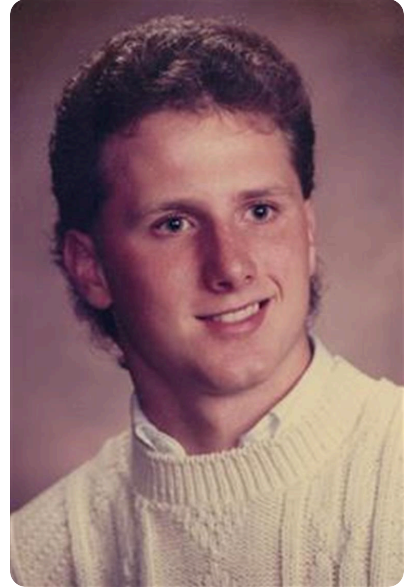
