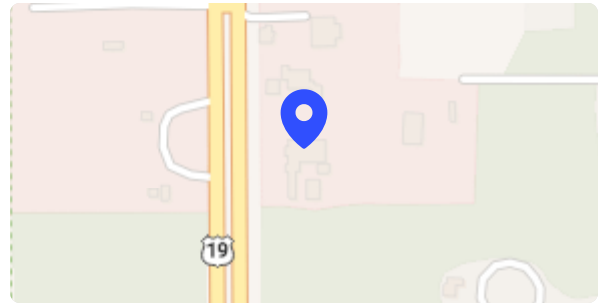

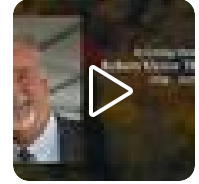

❤️The photo is Vic, Steve, Art and I at the Formula One Gran Prix in Indianapolis in 2007. Vic made it happen. Of course he did !

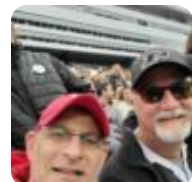
