Joseph "Giuseppe" Stanganelli, 83, of Clearwater, FL, USA, passed away peacefully on June 16, 2025, surrounded by his wife, son, brother, sister-in-law, nephew and niece.

Joseph spent over 55 years as a skilled mason in the construction industry. Hand building many local hospitals, schools and homes.

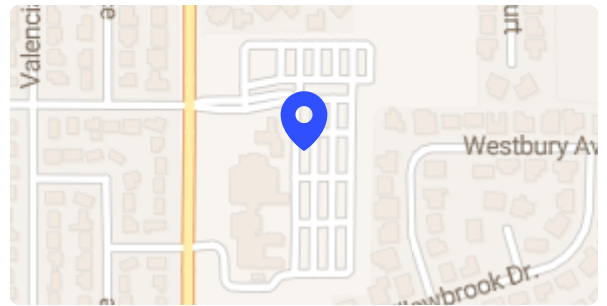

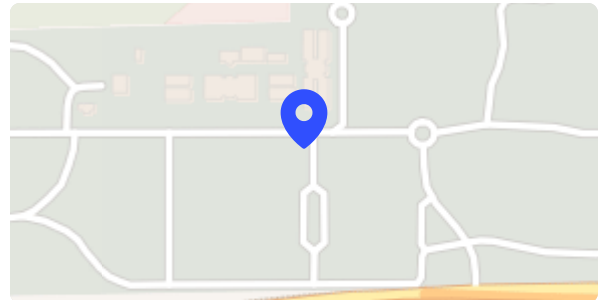
