It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of beloved wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother, Lucille M. "Penny" (DeCaro) Rinere, age 88, passed away peacefully on January 6, 2026, surrounded by her family. She was born on May 28, 1937, in Rochester, New York, to the late Louise and Armand "Norm" DeCaro.

Lucille dedicated her life to caring for others through her work as a social worker. She also served as a day care teacher, and parent liaison, at Small World Nursery and Kindergarten touching countless lives through her compassion and commitment to children and families. She was actively involved with the Society for the Protection and Care of Children (SPCC) in Rochester, New York.

Lucille was a devoted Catholic and held church affiliations with St. Joseph's Church in Penfield, New York, and St. Michael the Archangel Catholic Church in Clearwater, Florida. She attended Blessed Sacrament Catholic Elementary School, Nazareth Academy High School, and Graduated from Nazareth College in 1959.

She was predeceased by her husband, Frank J Rinere Sr.; her parents, Armand "Norm" and Louise DeCaro; her parents-in-law, Joseph and Pearl Rinere; her brother-in-law, Joseph C. Rinere, her sister-in-law, Gail M. DeCaro; and her son-in-law, Gregory J. Bileschi.

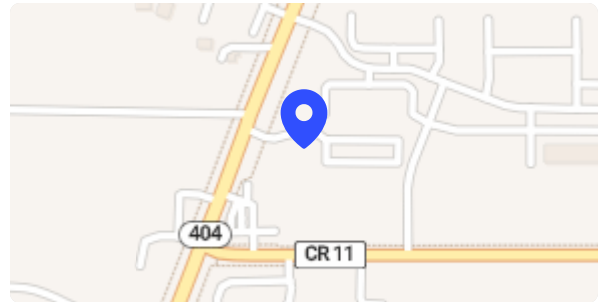

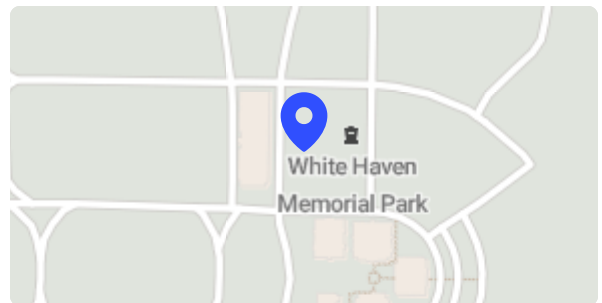

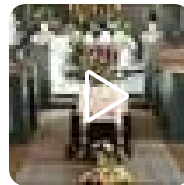
